

Synopsis of the Award

The award recognizes the achievements of outstanding Young Indian Entrepreneurs (aged between 25 to 40) who have established and have full grown successful business. The main purpose of the initiation of this award is to recognize the entrepreneurial spirit among youngsters and to encourage Indian youths into concentrating their energies into building their business as well as contribution to the Indian economy and job creation.

Nomination Process

- Award open to all Malaysian Indian aged between 25 to 40.
- An owner manager (not family business) primarily responsible for the success of the business (in business for at least 5 years).
- Business should be having a minimum paid up capital of RM100,000. Minimum Turnover / Contract value of RM 5 million for the past five years.
- Nomination must be done in the official form available and can be made by anyone who is familiar with the entrepreneur including himself.
- The following criteria will be used as a measurement in assessing and determining the winner:
 - Financial performance and growth of the company
 - Innovative Business Model
 - Success story and obstacles faced
 - Social responsibility by giving back to the community
 - Demonstrate strong leadership skill
- Business premises open for visit to the Awards Committee.

Selection Process/Awards Committee

This Committee will be chaired by YBhg. Datuk R. Theivandran, Board Member. The Institute of Internal Auditors Malaysia and the former Secretary General Ministry of National Unity and Social Development, Former Member of the Energy Commission, Malaysia and will be made up of prominent businessman and professionals. Partners of Big 4 Accounting Firm will also be members of the Awards Committee. The Committee will review the nomination received and select the winners. **The decision of the Awards Committee is Final.**
